2. Competition Roundup

Stockcar

- Track was acceptable, however slight modifications might have to be done to straighten edges of joins in the track.
- Track could possibly be numbered on the underside of the track to facilitate simple and easy assembly.
- During assembly, gaffa tape should be placed under the corner joins to give a flat side to the track.
- Rules to be refined and signed off on next meeting Cameron to action.
- Rope to section off spectators from the track.
- No more standing on the track.

<u>Sumo</u>

- Rules to be refined and signed off on next meeting Cameron to action.
- Stockcar track seemed to be enough of a barrier for the spectators with the sumo ring inside it.

<u>General</u>
